

AFFIDAVIT

BE IT ACKNOWLEDGED, THAT I, [REDACTED], of [REDACTED] deponent, being of legal age, do hereby depose and say under oath as follows:

This regards communications concerning my accounts with Morgan Keegan Brokers Paul Ehrlich and Jack Koch. I am a long-retired investor who requires safe income for monthly expenses. When Broker Paul Ehrlich first pointed out the Morgan Keegan funds to me he stated that these funds were well managed by our company and that he couldn't see anything wrong with them. He clearly understood my needs. We did not have a detailed discussion of risks. I trusted his recommendation.

In August 2007 the funds had dropped significantly in value. I asked Broker Jack Koch what should be done. Jack Koch advised that it was not the time to sell because the funds were too low then. To me this indicated that I should hold the funds until the value went up. After that neither Paul Ehrlich nor Jack Koch changed their advice to me and the funds continued to lose principal value.

Before I moved my account from Morgan Keegan to A G. Edwards, I was living on Social Security and about \$ [REDACTED] per month from my Morgan Keegan account. Now I have less than \$ [REDACTED] pr month from my much smaller account to live on. This reduction in principal has been a major hardship for me and my wife.

And I affirm that I believe the foregoing statement to be true. Witness my hand under the penalties of perjury this 20<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2009.
