Alabama Senate Confirms Hon. S. Dagnal Rowe as Commissioner

MONTGOMERY ALABAMA (January 22, 2014) Joseph P. Borg, Director, Alabama Securities Commission (ASC) announced that the Alabama Senate confirmed Commissioner Rowe for a four year term in a hearing today. Commissioner Rowe had received an interim appointment from Governor Bentley on August 19, 2013 to replace Commissioner Andrew P. Campbell whose term had expired.
