The **Alabama Securities Commission** (ASC) advises filers to plan ahead who use the North American Securities Administrators Association (NASAA) Electronic Filing Depository (EFD) that the system will be offline and unavailable to all filers and regulators Jan. 1-5. If your filing is due during those dates, ASC advises you to file before 11 p.m. Central Time Dec. 31, 2024 or file using a paper filing.

- The EFD will be updated and migrated to a new website, <u>nasaaefd.org</u>.
- EFD services will be offline and unavailable to all filers and regulators after 11 p.m. Central Time Dec. 31, 2024, through 6 a.m. Pacific Time Jan. 6, 2025.
- NASAA will migrate all usernames and passwords to the new site. EFD users will not need to update or change their credentials.
